







#### National regulatory initiatives in Europe

Belgium	<ul> <li>Bpost is required to reduce the CO2 emissions to a maximum of 74,946 tCO2e.</li> <li>Parcel lockers in Mechelen</li> <li>Return of e-Commerce items in Rixensart</li> </ul>
France	Obligation to publish information on CO2 emissions
Poland	<ul> <li>Low-Emission Transport Fund</li> <li>Electromobility Act</li> <li>Electromobility Development Plan</li> </ul>
Spain	<ul> <li>Law 31/2007 of 30 Oct. 2007 on contracting procedures in the water, energy, transport and postal services</li> <li>Spain's national integrated plan for energy and climate (PNIEC)</li> <li>The draft law on climate change and energy transition</li> </ul>




#### Greenhouse gasses in different sectors
