Competition law applies horizontally in all sectors, in addition to sector-specific regulation.

Antitrust and merger control cases abound in the telecoms and media sectors, with significant cases also occurring in the postal sector. The rise of the digital economy is challenging traditional antitrust approaches.

In the telecoms sector, antitrust interventions could even increase as EU policy potentially moves away from sector-specific regulation of significant market power (SMP).

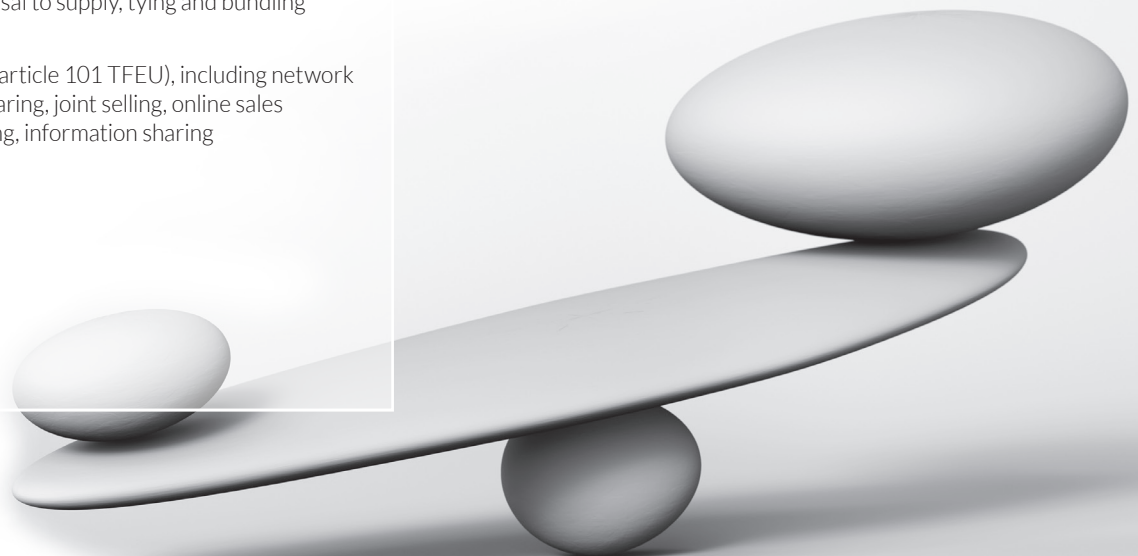
