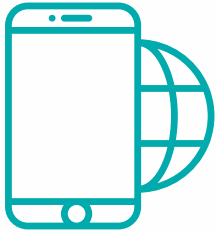

- **15 Central and Eastern European (CEE) countries** - Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia and Turkey.
